- A one-time (non-renewable) college scholarship will be awarded to the winner.
- The one-time scholarship can be used for tuition, room, board, textbooks or other educational expenses at any university or college in the United States. The check will be sent directly to the college of the winner to be applied to the designated expense.
- **The application deadline is 5 p.m., Friday, April 11, 2014.**
